DIRECTOR'S NOTE


As a director, I am drawn to stories that ask us to look honestly at ourselves. This play explores a character who builds a fortress to push people away and shut them out, believing it will keep him safe, only to discover that those walls end up hurting him in the end. That idea strongly connects to the way many teenagers build their own walls or fortresses to protect themselves, often without realizing the harm that comes from not letting others in.

I chose this play because I love its theme and message, and because of the powerful ensemble work required to bring it to life. This story cannot be told by one person alone. It depends on trust, vulnerability, and collaboration, both onstage and off.

My hope is that as you watch, you will reflect on what your own kryptonite might be and how you can cope with it, break down your own fortresses, and allow others in.

Thank you for being here, and enjoy the play.






Denton Millet
